## PROOEMIUM.

Cum excellant Responsoria Gradualia versuum luminibus, Offertoria, quod dolendum est, eis hoc tempore carent. Pridem quidem antiphonae ad Offertorium explendo longo temporis spatio, quod oblationis ritu terebatur, versus adiuncti erant simulque cantoribus vacabat, artis peritiam ostendere. Magno cursu fluentes, concinnitate numerorum insignes, eleganti elatione evolantes non repetunt saepius usitata modulamina, immo eorum proprium est, etiam atque etiam aures melismata in omnigenas formas variando permulcere. Ad divinum denique corripiunt animos impetum neumata ultimi versus, quibus imprimis Dominicis diebusque festis sollemnioris ritus nihil perfectius. Quantam maiestatem prae se ferant exempli gratia versus Offertorii *Ascendit Deus*, qualibus facibus ardeant versus Offertoriorum *Terra tremuit* et *Tui sunt caeli* modi hypophrygii, quam placido maerore perfundantur, qui Offertorio *Anima nostra* hypodorico adduntur, enarrari non potest. Nemo igitur eos Responsiorum Gradualium versibus multo praestare negabit. Recte ergo S. Odo Abbas Cluniacensis de iis sententiam tulit, S. Gregorium in offerendis et earum versibus, quantum in hac arte valuerit, patefecisse. Quam ob causam sane tempus esse videtur, ad decorem domus Dei evehendum eos ab oblivione immerita revocare.

In recensione praecipue celebri codice bilingui Montepessulano H 159 usus sum adhibitis ad comparationem maxime quoad ordinem versuum et intercalationes codicibus Sangallensi 339, Einsiedlensi 121, Laudunensi 239, Treverico Bohn. Quae in Montepessulano desiderantur, aliunde conquirenda erant. Versus n. 84, 95, 99, 106 debeo monachorum Solesmensium comitati. In appendice collegi aliquot cantus obsoletos dignos, ut mihi visum, qui restituerentur.
