## PREFACE

The Sacred Music Resource Center was established at Mount Marty College, Yankton, South Dakota in September, 1971. The main content of the Center spans a chronological period of chant publications dating from the Solesmes restoration (late 19th century) to the present. In addition to publications of chant, a few of the rare books of chant pedagogy are also included. Many of these publications were used in convents and monasteries throughout the United States in response to Pius X's *Motu Proprio on Sacred Music*, issued November 22, 1903. With the introduction of a vernacular liturgy since Vatican II, however, the Latin chants are no longer used as extensively as they once were. It is important, therefore, that this body of music be preserved whether for research or performance purposes. The collection of Mount Marty College is now at Sacred Heart Monastery and is available to researchers, librarians, and performers who are interested in this music. Inquiries are welcome at any time.

Other contributions came from St. Mary's Institute, O'Fallon, Missouri; Pius X School of Music, Purchase, New York; St. Joseph's College, Rensselaer, Indiana; and Msgr. Hubert A. Campo, through the Abbey of Mont César in Louvain, Belgium.

In the present catalog, a code will be used to indicate items which may be found in other Benedictine libraries. The catalog represents only those libraries which responded to the original request; it is, therefore, in no way all-inclusive. It is hoped that the collection will continually grow and eventually represent most of the major source areas in the United States.

At this stage of the project, only an alphabetical index is being issued. As the collection develops, a topical index may be published. The present listing does not include the collection of more familiar chant sources available in the general library of Mount Marty College and Sacred Heart Monastery.
